Can you practise balancing on one leg? How long can you balance for? Which leg can you balance on the longest? Can you beat your time?	Can you practise the correct letter formation of the letters in the alphabet? Be careful not to reverse letters ©
Personal, Social & Emotional (Self-Regulation & Managing Self & Building Relationships)	Talk about what you are good at and what you would like to get better at with your grown up. How will you improve this thing?	Can you talk about how the characters felt the stories you read (e.g. baby bear, the giant, the 3 little pigs) Have you ever felt this way? How did you get over this feeling?	Can you practise turn taking by playing board games together? Can you wait for your turn?	Can you discuss the classroom rules with your grown up? Can you talk about helpful and unhelpful behaviours?
Literacy (Comprehension & Word Reading & Writing)	Can you read your book and talk about what you liked and disliked about the story?
