Bag2School is the UK's leading textile recycler and fundraiser working with schools and since its inception in 1999 it has now paid out over £48 million. As well as raising vitally needed funds for Annecy's PTA and our school children, it also helps the environment by helping to divert unwanted textiles away from landfill. The collection is scheduled for Thursday 18th April 2024. All children have been sent a bag and information leaflet. If you are able to support, please bring filled bags on this date by 9am.

We are very excited to celebrate our love of books for World Book Day next Thursday! This year, we will be making top hats together at school prior to World Book Day and then on the day children can come to school either in their own clothes or with a World Book Day costume. They will then wear their top hats to a whole school reading assembly where they can read their favourite books (either brought in from home or chosen from the school library) together. Every child will receive a £1 World Book Day book token to get a FREE book! These can be swapped for a World Book Day book or you can get £1 off any book or audiobook costing £2.99/€3.99 or more. 
