## Communication and Language

- We will be reading a range of stories including 'Dinosaur Roar', 'Bumpus Jumpus Dinosaurumpus', 'Farmer Duck', 'Egg Drop, 'Tremendous Tractors' We will develop understanding of what we have been reading by retelling stories and narratives using our own words and recently introduced vocabulary:
- We will be using language to recreate roles and experiences using roleplay areas such as 'The Farm Shop' and 'The Farmer's House


## Literacy - Reading

- We will be continuing our ability to hear and say sounds in 3 and 4 letter words during daily Read, Write, Inc. phonics sessions.
- We will be using and understanding recently introduced vocabulary during discussions about stories, non-fiction, rhymes and poems and during role-play.
- We will be reading words and sentences consistent with our phonic knowledge by sound-blending (Fred Talking)


## Literacy - Writing

- We will be practising writing recognisable letters, forming most correctly.
- We will be practising spelling words by identifying sounds in them and representing the sounds with a letter or letters using 'Fred Fingers';
- We will be attempting to write simple phrases and sentences that can be read by others.
- We will be applying our skills by writing dinosaur fact books, farm booklets. labellina tractors etc..


## RSHE

- The Bear Card Feelings - linked to Zones of Regulations. Children will be identifying and recognising their own feelings
- Module 3-God is love , loving God and loving others.
