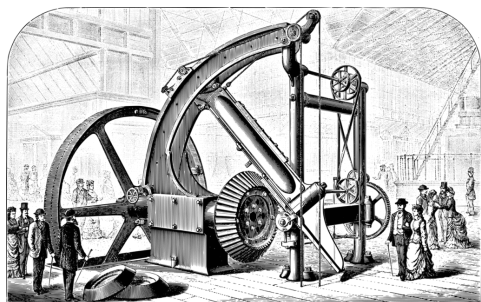


History - Victorians

Year 5 will study the significant turning point in British history extending students' chronological knowledge and establishing clear narratives across this period. Students will note connections, contrasts and trends over time as they widen their understandings of historical terms and address questions about change, cause, similarity, difference and significance.



Geography - Amazing Americas

In Geography, Year 5 will explore the Americas. We will begin to look at different climates in each country and how the climate will affect the lives of those animals and people living there!

Art

PE

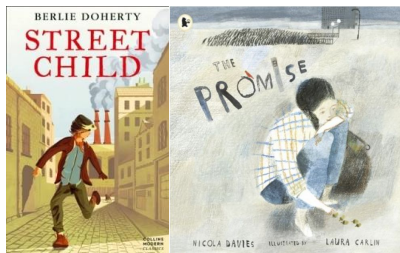
This term PE will be centered around athletic abilities. etc abilities and strategies through the participation of various athletic activities. We will also be doing swimming this term!

Computing

During this term students will develop their understanding of creating media. Students will be planning and shooting a movie.

Maths

Students will learn, during this term, about multiplication, division, fractions, decimals and percentages.



English

Students will read and discuss and increasingly wide range of fiction books this term. The Class text will be *Street Child* by Berlie Doherty. Students will deepen their understanding of the role of character development, emotional responses, and settings in narrative fiction. Additionally, students will refine their descriptive writing skills by paying particular attention to the use of grammar and vocabulary to enhance meaning. Students will start developing introductions and conclusions that include engaging descriptions of events with information organized chronologically.

Religious Education



This term students will develop a deeper awareness of mission, memorial sacrifice and transformations.

Science

Year 5 during the unit 'properties of materials' we will explore the different ways that materials can be described and what characteristics they have. This will prepare use to then look at what happens when we mix materials to create solutions - examining the changes in the materials!

RSHE

In RSHE we will be following ten:ten (parent access available). We will explore personal relationships and strategies to deal with conflict or pressure. Alongside we will continue to learn about internet safety and cyberbullying.

French

Students will learn how to discuss the weather in French. This unit will have a particular emphasis on the pronunciation of the vowel sound 'oh'.

Spellings

Similarly to last term, students will continue to practice their spellings of keywords weekly. New words will be taught on Wednesday and students will have a spelling review the following week.
