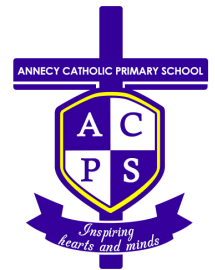

Dear Parents and Carers

29 April 2024

Swimming lessons have been arranged for Year 6 class at Seaford Head Pool. The course will begin on **Thursday 23rd May 2024** and will run on the following Thursdays:

- 23rd May, 6th, 13th, 20th & 27th June & 4th July

Children will be accompanied to and from the pool. The swimming lessons will begin at 2pm and we will return to school by the end of the school day. We ask that you make a payment of £15 through Parentpay. In accordance with safety regulations, there will always be at least one qualified lifesaver and swimming instructor in attendance.

There may be occasions when children are not able to attend sessions for a variety of reasons. In these circumstances, we would ask you to please inform the school office so that any children remaining in school can be supervised. The first session will be an assessment in accordance with health and safety procedures to ensure that children are taught, and progress, from their current ability level.

Children should bring their swimming bags containing a swimming hat, goggles if necessary and a towel; girls should wear one-piece swimsuits and wear their hair tied back, if possible plaited; boys should ideally not be swimming in baggy swimming shorts. Earrings are not to be worn for swimming lessons.

Your support in ensuring that the children are properly equipped would be greatly appreciated. The aim of the sessions is to improve swimming skills and achievement. In addition, I would be really grateful if one or two parents could assist with walking to and from the swimming pool each week. Please let the school office know if you can offer your time to help with this activity. Thank you.

Current medical advice regarding verrucae and athlete's foot is that these conditions do not prevent children from swimming; all children walk through a medicated footbath before entering the pool.

Please complete the payment online through Parentpay by Friday 10th May 2024. The slip below should be completed and returned to the office by Friday 10th May 2024.
